 3,293 families supported one-to-one; 182 trained parent guides, an increase of 45 guides.
- H&V ASTra Programs (Educational Advocacy Support and Training) Programs Count: 7; 371 families served; 38 ASTra Advocates; ASTra Basic Training conducted in 11 states and 450 individuals.
- Tech Support from HQ staff to chapters, programs and their leaders; responded to over 3,540 inquiries/reaches.
- Chapters held over 500 events for families in the U.S. and Canada reaching approximately 11,500 individuals.
